THEREFORE: A RIGHT RESPONSE

We've looked so much at our adoption and the reality of us being grafted into the True Israel, Jesus Christ. We've seen that Christ came to usher in a new Kingdom, one that is reigning now, but one that we are still eagerly waiting for its *full* envelopment of creation.

Over the course of **Romans 1-11**, Paul builds the momentum until he finally reaches a state of ecstasy as he considers the very things he is writing, when he exclaims his own response to this in **Romans 11.33-36**. But then he moves into what he considers to be our reasonable service; our right response in worship.

Tim Keller:

C.S. Lewis says, "it takes a community of people to get to know an individual person." Reflecting on his own friendships, Lewis observed that some aspects of one of his friend's personality were brought out only through interaction with a second friend. That meant if he lost the second friend, he lost the part of his first friend that was otherwise invisible. "By myself I am not large enough to call the whole man into activity; I want other lights than my own to show all his facets." If it takes a community to know an ordinary human being, how much more necessary would it be to get to know Jesus alongside others? By praying with friends, you will be able to hear and see facts of Jesus that you have not yet perceived.

- **Preach the Gospel to Yourself:** We already began our morning praising God and having the Gospel preached to us through the songs we sang and the Word preached, but this posture of praise is what leads us into the next movement towards confession and repentance.
- **Repent and Confess:** James 5.16 specifically tells us to repent to one another. When we get our sin into the light and have others in our corner, we walk in freedom.
- Ask: We want to specifically ask the Lord for equipping power as His church, as His people. We are asking for strength and for a filling of the Holy Spirit to empower us to be salt and light in the life that He has given us.
- Yield with Thanksgiving: We'll yield today by taking communion together, and then giving Him thanks and praise as we close our worship service as a church family singing His praises.


