COMMUNITY GROUP HOMEWORK

Open the evening by reading the **Call to Worship Psalm** and reciting the **Memory Verse** together. Then pray the **Psalm** and the **Memory Verse** to open discussion.

Read Proverbs 1.20-23. What stands out in these passages and from Sunday's sermon?

Preaching the Gospel to Yourself

What creates the most "noise" in the busy street of your heart and mind? What Gospel truths do you need to be reminded of that can pierce through that noise?

Your Life Mission

Our first duty on mission is to be satisfied in Christ and abiding in Him. Without that, our service will be like a clanging gong and utterly useless. Share what is *currently* a part of your trellis (even if it's weak or still new!). Then share what you would want to commit to add to your trellis. Are there any of these trellis pieces that can be done with others in the group?

End the evening in a time of prayer, praying through the theme of the night using the Lord's P.R.A.Y.er model with your group.

THE LORD'S P.R.A.Y.er MODEL

Preaching the Gospel to Yourself (Matthew 6.9, 10)

 Always begin your time of prayer focusing on God's goodness, who He is, and what He has done for us. Pray truths from this week's text.

Repent and Confess (Matthew 6.12)

Confess any particular sin that prevents you from walking out what God calls
us to in the text, or any other particular sin you are wanting to fight. Ask Him to
help you have strength to repent and run towards Him.


Ask for Provision (Matthew 6.11-13)

o Ask God for new perspective and for the things that you need. Once our hearts are fixed on Him, we can ask Him to help us with our needs. When your heart is begin filled with the Gospel first, your asking will be far more in line with God's desires and will. Ask Him to work in the relationships in your life that you are hoping to share God's love with.

Yield with Thanksgiving (Matthew 6.10)

 End your prayer by giving God thanks for His faithfulness and ask Him to help you trust and yield to His work and ways.
