THE "BODY" OF CHRIST?

In our day and age, our society values self-strength, reliance, and a "you got this!" mentality. But we do not "got this," and we aren't designed to "got this." Apart from Christ, we can do nothing! But when Christ ascended to heaven, He was gone, so now how can we tangibly be helped by Christ? He has given us His Spirit, and now we are collectively His body: His hands and feet to help one another.

However, since none of us *are* the total Christ, but only individual members of His body, we need the ministry of the *rest of the body* in order to be cared for, guided, loved, and sanctified through the diversity of relationships and gifts each member of the body has to offer the rest of the body.

on others or think too highly of yourself? Both perspectives need adjusting if we want


to be able to fully enjoy God's wisdom and design for us as one body. How do you need prayers for adjustment so that you can grow into becoming a more healthy,
