2 Corinthians 6.16 // March 31, 2024

PREPARING FOR COMPANY

When important guests come over, the first thought we often have is, "we have to get the house clean!" We plan and prepare to make it suitable, and the more important the guest, the higher the standard. God has said that He wants to make His dwelling among us and walk with us. We can work and work, but at the end of the day, we won't be able to cleanse ourselves enough to prepare for His holiness.

THE GOOD NEWS

But there is Good News for us! Because it is impossible for us to make ourselves clean enough, God knows this and devised a plan. He Himself would come down, and by His power over sin and death He would take upon all of our sin and filthiness and obliterate it. He alone was worthy and able to do this, and He did this to make a way for us.

Revelation 5.1-14

**Just as it is impossible for us to enter Heaven by our own strength,
It is *equally* as impossible for death to *keep* Jesus
from Heaven by *its* own strength.**

Christ came to free you from the power of your own sin, to heal your broken heart, to give mercy and grace to His enemies, bring hope to the hopeless, and heal the hurting and mourning.

PERFECTLY CLEANSED

We have been given hope! But our hope can never be in our ability to make things right with God. We will not pass His CSI inspection! But we are able to put our faith in the cleansing work of Jesus. Only when we ask *Him* to come into us and cleanse us can we be born again as brand new and clean, and God's Word is clear: there is no such thing as being "on the fence," you must be born again (**John 3.3**).

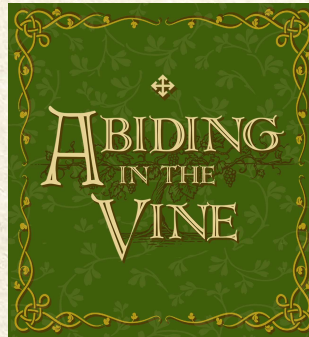
