PAUL'S LEGACY

Philippians 2.3 // 1 Thessalonians 2.8

What you leave behind is not what is engraved into stone mountains, but what is woven into the hearts of others. -Pericles

Paul's goal was not *only* to share the Gospel, but to share his entire life. He fell in love with the people he ministered to. He did not just love to preach the Gospel to people, but he loved the *people* that he preached the Gospel to.

TO THE SHEPHERDS

None of us will live forever in *this* life, but we *can* do things that *will* last forever into the *next* life.

- Yield with Thanksgiving (Matthew 6.10)




