Open the evening reciting the Memory Verse together. Then open to the Call to Worship Psalm and have someone open the night by praying the Psalm.


Read 1 Corinthians 9.19-23, 10.31-11.1. What stands out here and from Sunday's sermon?

As believers, we are to imitate Christ who incarnated Himself into this world. He was free from all and under no obligation to serve us, yet He humbled Himself and chose to do so. Paul also had rights and freedoms, yet set those aside for the sake of the Gospel. This is a hard example for us to follow as we've been raised in a culture that insists upon rights and freedoms and gets irked when things don't go our way. But the Gospel reminds us that if we want to be first, we must become last, and that Christ Himself lowered Himself that we might be saved.
