Acts 28.1-10 // September 8, 2024

MISINTERPRETING TRAGEDY

Paul and the occupants find themselves with great relief having survived, and even more relief when they find locals with "unusual kindness." But the celebration quickly turns to a gasp as Paul is bitten by a poisonous viper, leading the locals to wrongly assume Paul must have had it coming to him.

John 9.1-3

It is hard enough when we doubt ourselves, but it is much harder when those around us also doubt us.

This is when, again, it becomes so important for us to be anchored not in what is true, or what even *seems* to be true, but in what is "TRUTH."

DISTANT SECOND PLACE

If bad things happening was always the result of sin in our life, or God's displeasure towards us, we will have a hard time explaining the life of Jesus. Or Job. Or the man born blind at birth. Our perspective must shift.

I will never be treated worse than how Jesus was treated.
I will never receive worse than what Jesus received.
I will never endure worse than what Jesus endured.

Though there are many specific tragedies and pains we will endure that Christ did not specifically endure, what He *did* endure is far greater than anything we will ever endure, and that is the fury and anger of God against all the sin that He hates.

BLESS THOSE WHO CURSE YOU

The Maltese people's perception of Paul didn't sway him.

The Jews' perception of Jesus didn't sway Him.

Neither should others' perception of us sway us.

Christ calls us to bless those that curse us, and to owe no one anything except love. Though we will be falsely accused or have the worst assumed about us, our aim is not for the praise of man, but for the praise of God, that He may be honored and glorified even through our trials and tragedies.


