UNPREDICTABLE GRACE

Paul finds himself in a situation that honestly isn't new to him. He finds himself, under scrutiny, of course, but given an audience of curious listeners. Some skeptical, some cynical, but some genuinely interested. Some believe in the message he brings, while others (likely the majority) don't believe.

REALISTIC YET FAITH-FILLED


What relationships in your life do you need prayer for as you hope to have more Gospel conversations and confidence in God to have those conversations, despite recognizing that you may be rejected?
