## **COMMUNITY GROUP HOMEWORK**

Open the evening by reading the **Call to Worship Psalm** and reciting the **Memory Verse** together. Then pray the Psalm and the Memory Verse to open up discussion.

Read 1 Corinthians 9.24. What stands out in this verse and from Sunday's sermon?

### Preaching the Gospel to Yourself

Read **Philippians 1.6 and 2.12, 13.** These verses being near to each other in Paul's letter give us an interesting picture of our future: God *will* finish the work He began, but that does not mean we just sit around and wait! The way He finishes this work is through His working in us as we pursue Him. How does this Gospel truth help you find encouragement even amidst the challenges and failures of your own pursuit of a godly legacy? How also does it bring an important warning and challenge?

#### Your Life Mission

We are to run this race as one who runs to win, not one who just runs casually with no passion to win. This *must* require regular repentance from us, because we all too often run with no passion for Christ or for others.


What relationships are you hoping to "get in the race with" as you hope to pursue more meaningful conversation or relationships with? How can others be praying with you as you pursue those conversations?
