COVENANT RELATIONSHIP

"Covenant" isn't a word we often use in our relationships, but a covenant is what frames up God's relationship with His people. It is a commitment built up on relationship, which is why we call it the "covenant of marriage." It is not simply a contract or formal business agreement, but a relational commitment on both sides for mutual benefit.

It is not "too much" nor "demanding" for a spouse to insist upon faithfulness.

The same can be said about Christ and His bride.

THE INTEGRATED LIFE
