DON'T FORGET TO REMEMBER

In Peter's last recorded letter, he emphasizes his passion and conviction to always be reminding believers of the Gospel. It is, in some ways, a pastoral "mission statement" for all leaders to constantly be reminding those in their lives of the important Gospel truths that keep us walking with Jesus daily.

NEARSIGHTEDNESS

When someone is near-sighted, it means that they can only see what is close to them, sometimes even only the things that are right in front of their face. They can't see things in the distance. Peter says that we as believers easily become this way. We only see what is in front of us; what is immediate. Long distance vision is blurry to us, and it is difficult for us to see what is right in front of us in the greater context of the big, long term, eternal picture.

You can't know Him without knowing His Word, knowing Him in prayer, and knowing Him within His people, but you can know the Word, be in prayer, and be with His people and yet *not* know Him.




