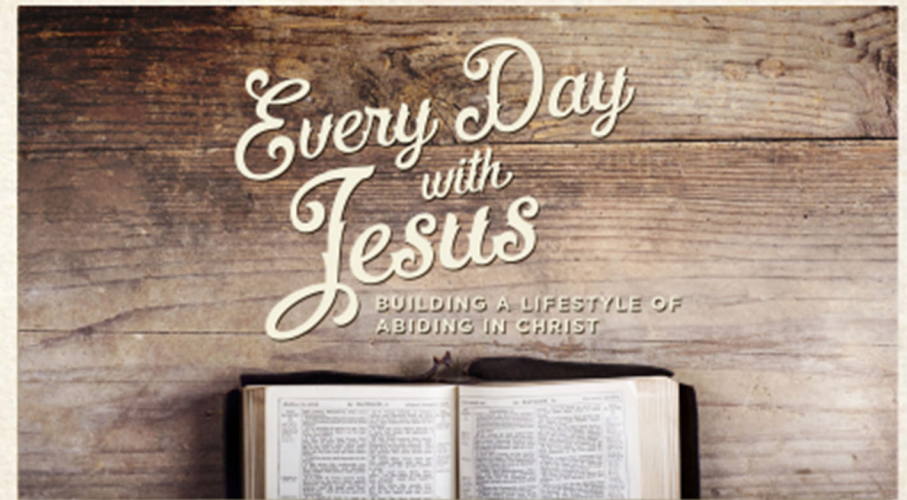
## THE LORD'S P.R.A.Y.er MODEL
