BECOME WHAT YOU ALREADY ARE

Hebrews 3.1-6 // April 13, 2025

HOLY BROTHERS AND SISTERS

Palm Sunday is the day we commemorate the beginning of the final week of Jesus' earthly life and ministry. It is the day He came into Jerusalem on a donkey to make a way for peace between God and man.

The author of Hebrews calls us "holy brothers." Though we were enemies and children of wrath, God enacted a fitting way to redeem us to be His children.

Ephesians 2.1-5 // Leviticus 20.7 // 1 Peter 1.14-16 // Matthew 5.20, 48

Mercy: not getting what you deserve. Grace: getting what you don't deserve.

TRUE AND BETTER MOSES

The author points to the most revered prophet of Judaism: Moses. He commends Moses for his faithfulness, but also makes it clear that Moses is not the one that should be venerated and adored, for Moses is just a servant and forerunner of a greater prophet, priest, and leader that would come.

The author uses an example of a building. When you see an incredible building, or something like a beautiful piece of art or a sculpture, it is true that the creation is amazing, but who really gets the glory and honor is the creator of those objects! A realistic painting isn't completely amazing in itself, since a simple photograph could do the trick (and even be more accurate). What *is* amazing is that someone actually created it! Thus, Moses was an honorable servant of the Lord, but Christ is the builder. He is the true and better Moses.

BE HOLY, FOR I AM HOLY

When an orphan is adopted, or two people become married, it is 100% true that the child has a new identity and name, and the couple have become one, but that doesn't mean that they *living out* and *living according to* what they truly are. While we can not *become* holy on our own, once we are made to be holy, we *can* now start pursuing our identity.

Colossians 3.1

If then you have been raised with Christ, seek the things that are above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God.

Which friends or relationships are you praying for and plan to invite to either or both of those services, or to have meaningful interactions or conversations with?


