Hebrews 3.12-19 // April 27, 2025

AN ENCOURAGING WARNING

It is easy to start almost anything, but it is an entirely different thing to finish well. The author of Hebrews does not want his readers to miss out on this "so great a salvation," and he gives a warning to them of that possibility. From these verses, there are at least two things we can recognize:

- 1. Since we are told to "take care," this means we must do something to prevent this hardening of heart.
- This is not a warning simply for those who don't profess to know Christ, but it is a warning to people who do profess to know Christ, who have seen the work of God.

PICK YOUR POISON

Proverbs 27.5. 6

Nine Ways We Minimize Sin

(Based in part on "Gospel-Centered Life" by Bob Thune)

- **Defending:** Do you justify your actions, even using Scripture to do so?
- Faking: Do you put on a different face/image around people than in private?
- **Hiding:** Do you avoid relationships that call you out?
- Exaggerating: Do you make yourself sound better (or worse) than you are?
- Blaming: Do you say, "I'm sorry, but..."
- Downplaying: Do you say, "what's the big deal," or "it's not like I'm [something worse]." Or
 "this is different"
- **Comparing:** Do you compare yourself to others, for better or worse?
- Being a Victim: Do you find ways to have people feel sorry for you so that they stop addressing your issues?

SO, HOW WILL WE EQUIP OURSELVES?

Hebrews 10.24, 25 // Philippians 1.27, 28

Our faith is not private. Personal, yes, but not private.

- Community Groups: This is one of the primary ways that we grow in our faith. Being committed to growing, praying, and worshipping with others over the course of time makes a huge impact on the maturity of our faith.
- **Fight Club:** One on one, relational discipleship is crucial to our growth. We need to learn how to fight *for the Gospel* in each other's lives. This is the essence of Fight Clubs.


Close the Community Group by praying through the pattern of the Lord's Prayer!
