IMPOSSIBLE TO REPENT?

Hebrews 6.4-8 // June 8, 2025

DULL OF HEARING

Principle 1: Clear things interpret the unclear things.

When things are unclear in any communication or desire for understanding, we ought to appeal to the most clear information we have in order to make sense of the less clear. This helps us understand context better.

Principle 2: Possible is not equal to probable.

It is "possible" that the building we are sitting in randomly took shape after a storm, with all of the pieces falling into place, but it is more probable that there is a builder and designer. Likewise, it is "possible" that everything came from nothing, but it is far more logical and probable that there is a creator or designer behind it all. Just because something is possible, does not at all necessarily mean that it is probable.

MISSION IMPOSSIBLE

So what do we do with this "impossible" word? Who is it describing? Firstly, it ought to be abundantly clear that *anyone* who comes to Christ to be saved by Him and to follow Him will not be turned away. And if we believe this is not talking about someone who is truly born again, it seems clear that the author is speaking of another type of person: someone who has enjoyed the benefits of Christianity without ever actually being born again.

John 6.37-40 // Hebrews 12.15-17 // 2 Corinthians 7.10, 11 // Romans 1.28

Tears mean nothing without repentance.

FOR US AND FOR OUR JOY

Ultimately, this warning is to serve our ultimate joy. If we, as Paul says, "pass the test," we can know that we have for ourselves "better things, things that belong to salvation."

"Beling" in Greek: "Possessed" by salvation. We can rest in assurance that we are truly possessed by the salvation of God.

Who in your life have you maybe given up on a bit, and need to rekindle a prayerful pursuit of sharing the Gospel with them?


