SHOW ME THE MONEY

Despite the stark warning given in the previous verses, the author makes it clear that his goal is that he wants them to have confidence and assurance of their salvation. And he points out that he *does* have confidence in their salvation for one primary reason: they have proved it.

1 John 5.13

FAITH AND WORKS

James 2.14-26

Paul and James might, on the surface, seem to contradict each other. But looking more thoughtfully at what they say and how they use the word "justified" helps us.

- Paul was writing to people who believed you had to earn salvation with works. So he emphasized "being justified by faith alone."
- James was writing to people who believed that some kind of thin, simple belief is all one should worry about. So he emphasized that "works justifies our faith."

Paul is talking about INITIAL salvation.

James it talking about EVIDENCE that initial salvation was real.

Showing good works is the justification that the claim that your justification by faith is real.


