

THE EASTER EGGS OF THE BIBLE

Hebrews 7.1-25 // August 3, 2025

MELCHIZEDEK, MAN OF MYSTERY

- Melchizedek lived during Abraham's life, around 2000 B.C.
- Abraham was the first person that called a Jew; God promised that he'd have *many* descendants that would become the Jewish people.
- Abraham recognizes him as the King of Salem as well as a Priest of the Most High God.
- Salem in Hebrews is "Peace" (Shalom). This was the name of Jeru(SALEM) before David took it over and renamed it.
- It is also 430 years before God established a priesthood for His people.

HIDING CLUES IN PLAIN SIGHT

Some of the Hundreds of "Easter Eggs" in the Old Testament:

- He will be betrayed by a friend who ate bread with Him.
- This 'friend' will betray Him by handing Him over to the authorities for thirty pieces of silver; then, that payment would be thrown down to the potters in the temple, which is a burying place for strangers.
- He will be rejected, beaten, mocked, and have His beard plucked out.
- His clothes will be gambled for.
- Though mocked and accused, He would be silent before His accusers.
- He would be scourged and crucified; yet crucifixion was not invented until hundreds of years after this prophecy.
- He would be executed alongside sinners.
- None of His bones will be broken. This is significant because due to the method of crucifixion (which again, wasn't invented for hundreds of more years), executioners would break the legs of the condemned in order to speed up the process of death. This was part of the command for the Passover lamb in **Exodus**, that the Hebrews were not to break any bones of the lamb. It was a foreshadowing of *the* Lamb of God.
