

TOTAL, FINAL, AND SUPREME

Hebrews 9.23-10.18 // September 7, 2025

PLEASE BE SEATED

The author of Hebrews continually wants his readers to be assured of the totality, finality, and supremacy of Christ's work on the cross. In doing so, he reminds us that because Christ's sacrifice is so perfect, there is no longer any need for us to offer up sacrifices for our sin.

1. Jesus Did Not Enter Repeatedly Like the Priests Did: 9.25, 26, 10.5-7

1 John 3.19-21 // Psalm 50.9-15 // Psalm 51.16, 17 // John 6.28-29

Additionally, he lets the readers know that while the priests stood before the Lord daily, this greater High Priest made His sacrifice and now *sits* at the right hand of God. Why is that? Because the work is finally finished. Beyond that, even now we are caused to sit *with* Him. Why? Because the work is finally finished.

2. Priests Stand Daily Offering the Same Sacrifice: 10.11, 12

Ephesians 2.4-6 // Colossians 3.1-4

PERFECTED AND BEING PERFECTED

So yes, we *rest* knowing that the work has been finished, and he also tells us then, that we have already been made perfect! But this does not mean that we just sit around in that rest and do nothing. In fact, while we have been perfected, we are still also in the meantime *being perfected* in the process of sanctification.

3. He Has Perfected for All Time Those Being Perfected: 10.14

1 Peter 1.3-5 // Ephesians 1.13, 14

NOTHING LEFT TO DO

Given all of this, we can rest assured that there is no more need for any sacrifice for our sin. We *do* give Him sacrifices and offerings in life, but not for our sin. We die to selves, put to death the deeds of the flesh, and give sacrifices of praise and thanksgiving, but none of these for the purpose of atoning for sin, but rather giving thanks and gratitude *because* of the atoning of our sin.

4. There is No More Sacrifice for Sin: 10.17, 18
