LAYING OUR LIVES DOWN

We live in a society that is becoming increasingly polarized, where cancelling, bullying, and even the threat of violence and death lurks in the shadows anytime anyone says anything that someone else disagrees with. We ought to hope and pray that as things seem to get worse, this will somehow bring about deep reflection, soul searching, and a return to civil discourse that may even bring about repentance and change. We need and hope for a revival.

**Revival doesn’t necessarily mean
a civil, moral, or cultural revival.**

What sets Christianity apart from other religions is that we don’t fight the way the world fights; whereas Islam’s cry is “death to infidel,” our cry is “death to self.” Rather than taking the lives of our enemies, we lay our lives down for our enemies.

FULL ASSURANCE

We do not put the hope of our salvation or the assurance of our future in our own strength, faithfulness, or ability to love God with all our heart, soul, mind, and strength.
