NO TURNING BACK

Hebrews 10.26-11.1 // September 28, 2025

The book of Hebrews is written to Jewish Christians who have been dealing with persecution for following Jesus and the New Covenant. It appears that some of them are tempted to give up and just go back to the Old Covenant, including the sacrificial system.

JESUS IS SUPERIOR

Hebrews 1:1-10:18 lays out the superiority of Jesus over everything that was so valuable in their Old Covenant experience – Jesus is superior to the prophets, angels, Moses, and every high priest. The New Covenant in Jesus' own blood is superior to the Mosaic Covenant which is now obsolete.

JESUS HAS ENDED THE SYSTEM OF SACRIFICE. BECAUSE OF HIM WE CAN ALL ENTER GOD'S PRESENCE

The author of Hebrews draws two big conclusions: (1) the sacrifice of Jesus on the cross has brought to a conclusion the entire sacrificial system. There is no longer any sacrifice for sin remaining, because Jesus' sacrifice is final and complete. (2) All of us in Christ now have complete access to the Presence of Almighty God in the Most Holy Place, in the real temple, not the earthly one which was just a copy and a shadow of the real one.

THERE'S NO TURNING BACK NOW, ONLY A GLORIOUS FUTURE, SO KEEP ENDURING TO THE END

These Jewish Christians are now exhorted to persevere because there is nothing to turn back to. The Old Covenant is done and gone. They need to keep enduring, confident that Jesus will return and fulfill every promise that has been made.

None of us today are tempted to go back to the Old Mosaic Covenant, but we are tempted to turn back from the knowledge of the truth we have received. We are tempted to think in terms of "works-righteousness", youget-what-you-deserve thinking, instead of the wonderful truth of Grace abundantly given from a Father who loves us unconditionally.


Our Community Groups are on break for summer! But while they are, make sure you stay connected.
