Hebrews 10.23, 24, John 17.1-26 // October 5, 2025

HOW CAN WE LOSE OUR SALVATION?

If you have had a relationship or friendship where you weren't convinced of their love or dedication to you, you know that it is a very anxious, worrisome kind of experience to live in that. There is no confidence or true freedom. Even if the other person *truly is* 100% committed, we can still (wrongfully) doubt their commitment and be suspicious of their love. And we lose out.

Galatians 3.16 // John 17.1-26

We are secure in God because Christ is secure in God. If we are hidden in Christ and have had His righteousness given to us, then we can't be turned away.

**You *can* be turned away from God,
but only if *Jesus* is turned away from God.**

PROMISES OF PERSEVERANCE

He who called you is faithful; He paid dearly for your life and salvation, and He will *not* then just let you walk away or be stolen from Him.

Early 20th century theologian G.K. Chesterton once replied to a newspaper editorial that asked its readers the question, "Dear Readers: What is wrong with the world?" G.K. replied with a simple, succinct answer:

**Dear Sirs,
I am.
Yours Truly, G.K. Chesterton**

It is hard to be committed to broken people, but when we recognize that we are also broken and part of "the problem," it helps to humble us and trust God's wisdom and ways. Christ prayed that His people would be one, and He gives us His wisdom and command to be committed and submitted one to another for not only our own growth, but also for the growth of those around us.
