THE TEMPTATION TO GIVE UP

Life gets wear. Whether it's the economy, money, parenting, politics, violence, sickness, temptation, discouragement, loss, or any number of other hardships we face, we have a massive need for the encouragement to endure. And no believer, whether brand new to the faith or seasoned and battle-scarred, is exempt from this great need.

Psalm 25.1-7, 10, 11, 14-21

Faith if the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen.

HEROES DESPITE THEMSELVES

The whole next chapter of Hebrews 11 is often called the "Hall of Faith," because it is essentially seven or so portraits of faith from what the author calls "the people of old." For readers today, we often tend to prop these men up to be heroes, and of course there is some merit to that, however the reason this "Hall of Faith" exists is *not* to prop up them or their accomplishments, but to highlight their dependence on God Almighty *despite* their weaknesses.

The heroes of the Old Testament are not the heroes.

If you are weak, fallen, worn out, and even laying on the ground and barely able to move, if you are at very least facing the right direction towards God, that is enough mustard seed faith to get you to the next step.

Don't put your faith in the strength of your faith.

Put your faith in the strength of Christ's faithfulness

despite your weakness of faith

HELP TO THE FINISH LINE

We walk by faith, and not by sight. While we do very much groan in this life and often come to our wits' end, we have been given a Helper to carry us through each groaning and each suffering and trouble, and He will take us to the finish line, even if He must carry us across it nearly lifeless.

Romans 8.18-32 // 2 Corinthians 4.16-5.10 // John 6.66-69

We can't see this seal. We can't see the finish line. We can't see how God is going to make "all things work together" for our good. But we with confidence have assurance for the things that we hope for, because we can survey God's Word and our own lives and know that He is a God who will save, even when we are pushed over the edge.

Who in your life has God brought you that you hope to be able to come alongside them to help them with the hope of the Gospel?


Close the Community Group by praying through the pattern of the Lord's Prayer!
