Hebrews 13.8-10 // March 22, 2026

THE UNCHANGING NATURE OF CHRIST

The author bookends his epistle with a reminder that God is unchanging and remains the same forever. This is the foundation of our faith: that although we change, ebb, and flow, Christ remains constant. This is what gives us confidence to draw near to Him *even when* we are being tossed about.

Hebrews 1.10-12

STRENGTHENED BY GRACE

When Paul first brought the Gospel to the Galatian church, the Jews there were living faithfully Jewish lives, striving to honor God by doing all the sacrifices and traditions they were commanded. When they first believed in Christ, they were exceedingly joyful that the Messiah had come to fulfill all the Law. But soon, their confidence in the work of Christ began to fade, and they reverted back to their previous works in order to “finish” the work of Christ.

**When the Gospel fades, but sin remains,
we fill up with shame and legalism,
rather than acceptance and grace.**

Galatians 1.6-9, 2.16, 20, 21, 3.1-3, 10,

**To insist on our good works and sacrifice to keep our salvation
secure is an offense to the Father, an offense to the Son,
and an offense to the Spirit.**

GOD’S FAITHFULNESS TO HIMSELF

God has not *primarily* made His promise for Abraham and all believers *to those believers*, but He made those promises to believers *by primarily making the promise to Christ*. And now, if we are “in Christ,” we are recipients of these great and many promises!

**Don’t let anyone tell you otherwise that the grace of Christ is
sufficient. Don’t listen to your heart condemn you, don’t be led
away by “diverse and strange teachings,” and don’t even let
an *angel* bring you a message other than the Gospel.**

Close the Community Group by praying through the pattern of the Lord's Prayer!

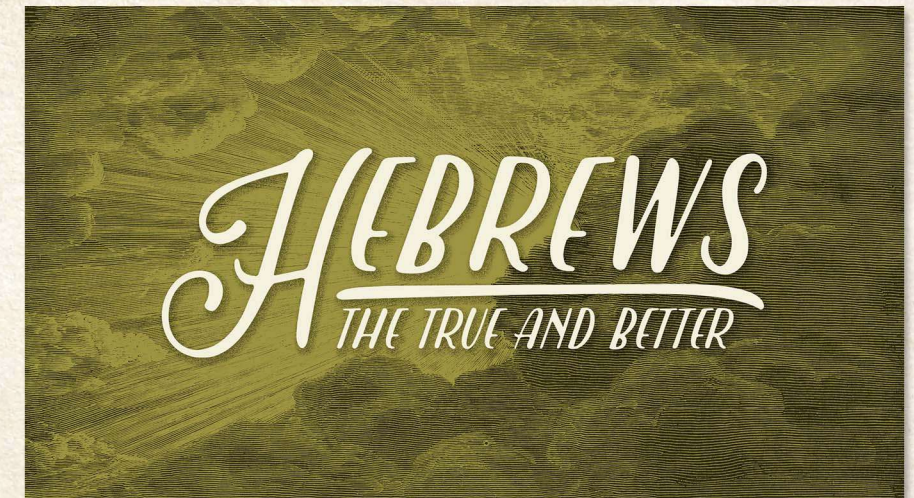
