ON A NEED TO KNOW BASIS

There are things we wonder, and there are things that we desperately want answers to, but we are not guaranteed to know these things. Sometimes, God might give us a sneak peak, or some hint at what He's doing, but even those aren't promised to us.

The good news for us, however, is that there *are things* that He *has* revealed to us; things which He has chosen to show us in His great and many promises that He has spoken through His Son and which has had recorded in His Word.

Preaching the Gospel to Yourself

Life is discouraging, frustrating, and confusing. We want answers, or at least we want to know reasons, for why things happen, and yet those reasons evade us. How does the incomprehensibility of God actually bring you comfort and peace amidst all of it?

Your Life Mission

God has called us all to trust Him, even when we can't see or understand what He is doing. Like Peter in last week's passage, we don't understand (or agree) with God's plan to do something seemingly trivial or that doesn't seem to be of much help, yet we trust Him and obey anyway.

There are people in our lives that it seems would never come to faith in Christ, or never discuss Jesus, the afterlife, or take you up on an invitation to get coffee or come to church. But maybe it would be God's desire for you to step out in faith, despite your own logic and assessment. Who in your life could you use prayer for, to give you faith not in them, but faith in an incomprehensible God who saves not according to what we see or think, but by His own will and desire?

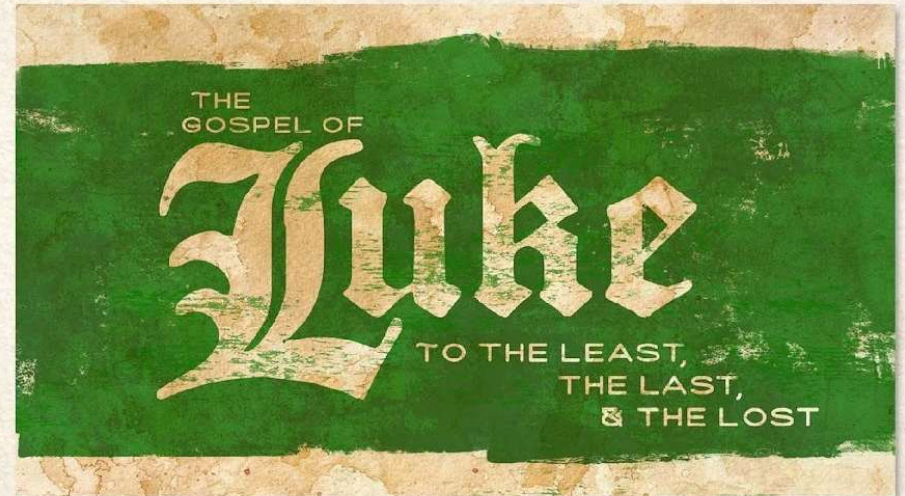
